1	May 16 (Sunday)	Arrival at Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv. Please choose flights that arrive before 3pm , to allow yourself time to clear passport control and pick up your luggage before joining the group bus to your hotel in Netanya. 2	May 17 (Monday)	Prepare food parcels (optional) and deliver them to the elderly club that ONE FOR ISRAEL supports. Visit ONE FOR ISRAEL’s Israeli headquarters and Bible College . Enjoy a lunch (included) with ONE FOR ISRAEL staff. Learn about	Netanya Seasons Hotel or similar

Messianic Jewish believers in Israel today and become familiar with the vision and programs. Meet with Arab and Jewish staff members who will share their testimonies and about their present ministry outreach. **Visit Caesarea** where Peter preached to Cornelius (Acts 10) and Paul gave his defense before Roman governors (Acts 24-26).

(Tuesday) | Travel to Haifa and meet with a local Messianic ministry. Enjoy a panoramic view over Haifa Bay and remember Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Visit Nazareth to connect with a local Arab Christian pastor to learn about his work. Enjoy a panoramic view over the city (from the eastern side). (Wednesday) | Travel up to the northern borders to pray over Lebanon and Syria. Visit Tel Dan (I Kings 12/Judges 18) and Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16). Continue to the Golan Heights for a view into Syria. | Sea of Galilee,

(Thursday) | Visit the traditional location for the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We will view the remains of a fishing boat from the time of Yeshua and, if time permits, a short visit to the archaeological exhibit at the Yigal Alon Museum to see archaeological finds from Jewish towns in the Galilee from the time of Jesus.. Tour Capernaum , Yeshua's ministry base. Enjoy a fish lunch together (included). Visit the synagogue at the town of Magdala (probable home of Mary Magdalene) Stop at the Jordan River where there will be an opportunity for baptisms for those who choose. | Sea of Galilee,

6	May 21 (Friday)	Spend the day in the region of the Dead Sea. Stroll to the first waterfall at Ein Gedi where David hid from Saul (1 Samuel 24). Visit Masada, the palace-fortress of Herod the Great, used by the Zealots in the Great Jewish Revolt against Rome. As time permits, visit the museum with Masada's unique archaeological finds from King Herod's palace. There will be an opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Then UP TO JERUSALEM! Evening: Welcome in the Sabbath together.	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar
7	May 22 (Saturday)	Visit the Mount of Olives, the location of Yeshua's ascent and return, remembering all the events in the scriptures that took place here, as well as those that will come. Spend time at the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed before His crucifixion. Join a Messianic worship service. Continue to Bethlehem to meet with a Palestinian pastor and learn about his ministry and pray for his congregation. Visit the shepherd's cave and an olive wood shop owned by local Palestinian Christians.	Jerusalem, Prima Royale or similar
8	May 23 (Sunday)	Visit the Davidson Center to learn about pilgrimage to Jerusalem at the time of Yeshua. View the streets and steps of the Southwall Excavations. Join in prayer at the Western Wall. Visit the heritage center at Christ Church, with its rich history of Christian ministry to the Jewish people in the land of Israel. The rest of the afternoon is free for browsing the colorful bazaars of the Old City.	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar
9	May 24 (Monday)	Tour the Knesset (the Israeli parliament) and have a time of prayer near the Knesset and the Supreme Court. Spend time at the Israel Museum and view the 50:1 scale model of Jerusalem	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar

from Yeshua's time and the **Shrine of the Book**, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. Tour and share communion at the **Garden Tomb**.

10	May 25 (Tuesday)	On your last morning, meet with a Holocaust survivor who will share their testimony with the group followed by time to visit Yad Vashem , the Holocaust Memorial Museum. Enjoy a farewell lunch (included) in the town where the ark once stayed for 20 years until David took it up to Jerusalem (I Sam 6). Stop at Emmaus to remember Jesus' conversation with two disciples on the day of the resurrection (Luke 24). And then head for the airport for your flights home. (Please book flights that depart after 7pm).	No hotel included this night.
11	Nov 26 Wednesday	Arrive home with vibrant memories of Ancient Stones and Living Stones in the Land of Israel.

RATE (LAND ONLY) INCLUDES:

- ▶ Arrival & departure transfers from the airport as a group. **PLEASE DO NOT BOOK YOUR FLIGHTS UNTIL ONE FOR ISRAEL HAS CONFIRMED THAT THE TOUR HAS GATHERED THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS FOR THE CURRENT PRICING.** Once confirmed, you should choose flights that arrive on May 16 before 3pm (to allow for time for passport control and to collect your luggage before the group bus to your hotel). For departure, please choose flights that depart from Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv after 7 pm on May 25. Individuals wanting to arrive at or depart from the airport at other times will be responsible for arranging and paying for their own transportation.
- ▶ Nine nights' accommodation in a shared room for two people (additional payment for those requesting a room by themselves).
- ▶ Israeli breakfast and dinner daily, excluding dinner the last day.
- ▶ Three included lunches, as per itinerary: lunch with ONE FOR ISRAEL staff, a fish lunch on the Sea of Galilee, and a farewell lunch on the last day.
- ▶ Nine touring days with a professional and licensed English-speaking guide (plus arrival day)
- ▶ Air-conditioned luxury tourist bus or van, as per program
- ▶ Entrance fees to sites mentioned in the itinerary
- ▶ Luggage loaders at hotels
- ▶ Tips and gratuities for guide, driver, hotel staff (included in the total price, but to be brought in cash)

RATE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

- Flights to or from Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv

- Passport and visa fees if applicable (citizens of many countries, including the USA, need to pre-approve their visas online for a small fee)
- Lunches (except the three mentioned in the itinerary)

BOOKINGS AND RATES

- If a roommate cannot be assigned or is not wanted, single-room rates will apply.
- **Registration closes February 1, 2027 (or earlier, if the tour is full).**
- A **non-refundable** deposit of **\$400 per person** is required at the time of registration.

PAYMENT AND CANCELLATION PENALTIES

- **Final Payment** should be made by Feb 14, 2027
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after Feb 14, 2027
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after March 14, 2027
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs after April 14, 2027
