	June 6 (Saturday)	Travel day (for those coming from North America)	
1	June 7 (Sunday)	Arrival at Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv. Please choose flights that arrive before 3pm , to join the group bus to your hotel in Netanya. Dinner together at 18:30 followed by a group meeting for orientation and an opportunity to get to know the rest of the trip participants.	Seasons Hotel, Netanya or similar
2	June 8 (Monday)	Prepare food parcels and deliver them to the elderly club that ONE FOR ISRAEL supports. Visit ONE FOR ISRAEL’s Israeli headquarters and Bible School . Learn about Messianic Jewish believers in history and in Israel today and become familiar with the vision and programs. Meet with Arab and Jewish staff members who will share their testimonies and share about their present ministry outreach. Enjoy lunch	Seasons Hotel, Netanya or similar

(included) with ONE FOR ISRAEL staff. **Visit Caesarea** where Peter preached to Cornelius (Acts 10) and Paul gave his defense before Roman governors (Acts 24-26).
 Evening: **Teaching by OFI staff**

3 June 9 (Tuesday) Travel to Haifa and meet with a **local Messianic ministry**. Visit a viewpoint on **Mt. Carmel** to visualize the story of Elijah and the Prophets of Baal. Tour **Megiddo** (associated by some with New Testament Armageddon) and then continue to **Nazareth Village**, a reenactment of village life in Nazareth at the time of Yeshua. Connect with a **local Arab Christian pastor** to learn about his work, and arrive at your hotel by the **Sea of Galilee** at the end of the day.

4 June 10 (Wed) Travel up to the northern borders to pray over Lebanon and Syria. Visit **Tel Dan** (I Kings 12/Judges 18) and **Caesarea Philippi** (Matthew 16). Continue to the **Golan Heights** for a view into Syria. Evening: **Time of fellowship and sharing with OFI staff**

5 June 11 (Thursday) Begin the day **sailing on the Sea of Galilee**. There will also be an opportunity to view the remains of a **fishing boat from the time of Yeshua**. Visit the traditional location for the **Sermon on the Mount** (Matthew 5-7). Tour **Capernaum**, Yeshua's ministry base. Enjoy a **fish lunch** together (included). Visit the synagogue at the town of **Magdala** (probable home of Mary Magdalene).

| 6 | June 12
(Friday) | <p>Travel down the Jordan Valley to Qaser el-Yahud, the traditional baptismal site of Yeshua in the Jordan River. There will be an opportunity for baptisms for those who choose. The rest of the day will be spent in the region of the Dead Sea. Hike Ein Gedi where David hid from Saul (1 Samuel 24). Visit Masada, the palace-fortress of Herod the Great, used by the Zealots in the Great Jewish Revolt against Rome. End the day with an opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Then UP TO JERUSALEM! Evening: Welcome in the Sabbath together.</p> | Jerusalem,

(Saturday) | <p>Visit the Mount of Olives, the location of Yeshua’s ascent and return, and Dominus Flevit where He wept over the city of Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44). Spend time at the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed before His crucifixion. Join a Messianic worship service. Continue to Bethlehem to meet with a Palestinian pastor and learn about his ministry and pray for his congregation. Visit the shepherd’s cave and an olive wood shop owned by local Palestinian Christians.</p> | Jerusalem,

(Sunday) | <p>Visit the Davidson Center to learn about pilgrimage to Jerusalem at the time of Yeshua. View the streets and steps of the Southwall Excavations. Join in prayer at the Western Wall, before touring the Western Wall Tunnels, walking along the length of the Temple wall from the time of Jesus. Tour the Knesset (the Israeli parliament) and have a time of prayer in the area of the Knesset (the Israeli Parliament) and Supreme Court. Spend time at the Israel Museum and view the 50:1 scale model of Jerusalem from Yeshua’s time and the Shrine of the Book, which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls.</p> | Jerusalem

(Monday) | Ascend Temple Mount , the site of the two temples. Walk through the Old City, down the Via Dolorosa past the Church of the Holy Sepulcher . Visit the Pools of Bethesda and worship at St. Anne’s Church . In the afternoon, there is the option of enjoying a guided tour of the City of David excavations, Hezekiah’s Tunnel and the Pool of Siloam (included) or having a free afternoon for shopping in the Old City . Final evening together with OFI staff | Jerusalem

(Tuesday) | On our last morning, share communion at the Garden Tomb . Meet with a Holocaust survivor who will share their testimony with the group followed by time to visit Yad Vashem , the Holocaust Memorial Museum. Visit the Valley of David and Goliath . We’ll enjoy an early farewell dinner on our way to the airport (included). Please choose a flight that departs from Ben Gurion airport Tel Aviv after 11:00 pm. - Arrival & departure transfers from the airport as a group. **Please choose flights that arrive on June 7 before 3pm (to allow for time for passport control and to collect your luggage before the group bus to your hotel). For departure, please choose flights that depart from Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv after 11 pm on June 16** (flights that depart just after midnight on June 17 are also good choices.) Individuals wanting to arrive at the Tel Aviv airport at other times will be responsible for arranging and paying for their own transportation.
- Nine nights' accommodation in a shared room for two people (additional payment for those requesting a room by themselves).
- Israeli breakfast and dinner daily, including a farewell dinner on the last day.
- Two included lunches, as per itinerary: lunch with ONE FOR ISRAEL staff, and a fish lunch on the Sea of Galilee

- **Registration closes March 7, 2026 (or earlier, if the tour is full).**
- A **non-refundable** deposit of **\$300 per person** is required at the time of registration.
- **Final Payment** should be made by March 7, 2026
- 25% of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after March 7, 2026
- 50 % of total tour cost will be charged if you cancel after April 7, 2026
- 100 % of total tour cost will be charged if cancellation occurs after May 7, 2026
