Please choose flights that arrive before 3pm , to allow yourself time to clear passport control and pick up your luggage before joining the group bus to your hotel in Netanya. (Monday) | <p>Prepare food parcels and deliver them to the elderly club that ONE FOR ISRAEL supports. Visit ONE FOR ISRAEL's Israeli headquarters and Bible College. Learn about Messianic Jewish believers in Israel today and become familiar with the vision and programs. Meet with Arab and Jewish staff members who will share their testimonies and share about their present ministry outreach. Tour Megiddo (associated by some with New Testament Armageddon) and then continue to Nazareth Village, a reenactment of village life in Nazareth at the time of Yeshua. (Wednesday) | <p>Travel up to the northern borders to pray over Lebanon and Syria. Visit Tel Dan (I Kings 12/Judges 18) and Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16). Continue to the Golan Heights for a view into Syria.</p> <p>Evening: Time of fellowship and sharing with OFI staff</p> | Sea of Galilee,

5	Nov 5 (Thursday)	<p>Begin the day sailing on the Sea of Galilee. There will also be an opportunity to view the remains of a fishing boat from the time of Yeshua. Visit the traditional location for the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Tour Capernaum, Yeshua's ministry base. Enjoy a fish lunch together (included). Visit the synagogue at the town of Magdala (probable home of Mary Magdalene). Stop at the Jordan River where there will be an opportunity for baptisms for those who choose.</p>	Sea of Galilee, Ron Beach or similar
6	Nov 6 (Friday)	<p>Spend the day in the region of the Dead Sea. Hike Ein Gedi where David hid from Saul (1 Samuel 24). Visit Masada, the palace-fortress of Herod the Great, used by the Zealots in the Great Jewish Revolt against Rome. There will be an opportunity to float in the Dead Sea. Then UP TO JERUSALEM! Evening: Welcome in the Sabbath together.</p>	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar
7	Nov 7 (Saturday)	<p>Visit the Mount of Olives, the location of Yeshua's ascent and return, and Dominus Flevit where He wept over the city of Jerusalem (Luke 19:41-44). Spend time at the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed before His crucifixion. Join a Messianic worship service. Continue to Bethlehem to meet with a Palestinian pastor and learn about his ministry and pray for his congregation. Visit the shepherd's cave and an olive wood shop owned by local Palestinian Christians.</p>	Jerusalem, Prima Royale or similar
8	Nov 8 (Sunday)	<p>Visit the Davidson Center to learn about pilgrimage to Jerusalem at the time of Yeshua. View the streets and steps of the Southwall Excavations. Join in prayer at the Western Wall, before touring the Western Wall Tunnels, walking along the length of the Temple wall from the time of Jesus. Walk</p>	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar

through the Old City, down the **Via Dolorosa**, stopping at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. The rest of the afternoon is free for browsing the **colorful bazaars of the Old City**.

9	Nov 9 (Monday)	Ascend Temple Mount , the site of the two temples. Visit the Pools of Bethesda and worship at St. Anne’s Church . Tour the Knesset (the Israeli parliament) and have a time of prayer in the area of the Knesset and the Supreme Court. Spend time at the Israel Museum and view the 50:1 scale model of Jerusalem from Yeshua’s time and the Shrine of the Book , which houses the Dead Sea Scrolls. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of the City of David excavations, Hezekiah’s Tunnel and the Pool of Siloam . Final evening together with OFI staff	Jerusalem Prima Royale or similar
10	Nov 10 (Tuesday)	On your last morning, share communion at the Garden Tomb . Meet with a Holocaust survivor who will share their testimony with the group followed by time to visit Yad Vashem , the Holocaust Memorial Museum. Visit the Valley of David and Goliath. We’ll enjoy an early farewell dinner (included) on our way to the airport. Please choose a flight that departs from Ben Gurion airport Tel Aviv after 11:00 pm. (Flights that depart just after midnight on November 11 are also good choices.)	No hotel included this night.
11	Nov 11 Wednesday	Arrive home with vibrant memories of ancient stones and Living Stones in the Land of Israel.

Return to Tel Aviv In the late afternoon, drop off at the airport for those wishing to spend the Sabbath in Jerusalem or Tel Aviv, or at the Season Hotel in Netanya (for those wishing to stay in the same hotel where they will be staying the first night of the tour beginning Nov 1.)
