## **Study Questions**

- 1. Did Yeshua come to fulfill the law, or abolish it? Read Matthew 5:17-37
- 2. If Yeshua fulfilled the law, does that mean our actions make a difference in our salvation? (pick all that apply)
  - a. We aren't saved by works, only through grace but we should still make sure our hearts are right before God
  - b. Our actions don't affect our salvation, but can grieve the Holy Spirit (1 Thessalonians 5:19)
  - c. Our works and actions determine our salvation
  - d. Yeshua weighs our good deeds against our bad deeds.
  - e. Yeshua's sacrifice brought us freedom from the condemnation of the law
- 3. What does it mean to keep the spirit of the law?
- 4. Read Romans 8:1-4. What was the purpose of the Torah?
- 5. Take some time to reflect on God's laws in the light of Yeshua's interpretation. Write some of your thoughts about your relationship with Torah as a follower of Yeshua.
